One award is presented annually to each University offering a degree in Physical Education or a related discipline.

Purpose

- To recognize outstanding undergraduate student leadership in the field of physical education or a related discipline.
- To promote a better understanding of the work of PHE Canada among undergraduate students.
- To encourage PHE Canada involvement in regional student conferences.

Eligibility

To qualify for this award, candidates must be 2nd or 3rd year undergraduate students in physical or health education or a related discipline.

How to apply

To apply for this award, candidates must be nominated by their PHE Canada University Faculty Representative.

Selection

The PHE Canada University Faculty Representative selects the award recipient for their respective universities.

Distinguished recipients will receive the following:

- an award certificate,
- a 1-year enhanced student membership to PHE Canada which includes a 1-year subscription to the Physical & Health Education Journal;
- An invitation to attend the PHE Canada/AAHPERD Student Leadership Conference in September 2010.

The presentation ceremony for this award is left to the discretion of each University.
